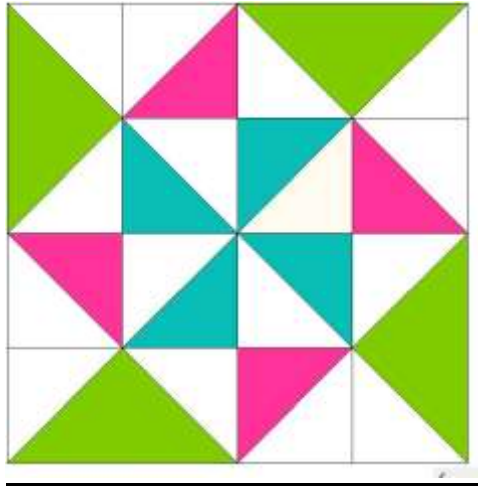


Cov-ercome

Block #1 – Be Adventurous



Cutting

Blue fabric

Cut two 4" squares

Green fabric

Cut four 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

White fabric

Cut eight 3 1/2" squares

Cut four 4" squares

Pink fabric

Cut two 4" squares

Make the 4 flying geese (green/white blocks)

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of the 3 1/2" white squares. With RST, align one 3 1/2" square with one edge of the 3 1/2" 6 1/2" rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn diagonal line. Cut 1/4" beyond the stitched line. Fold open and press.

Repeat with a 3 1/2" square on the other side. Press. You should have four 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" flying geese.

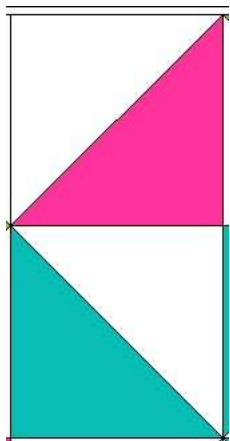
Make the HST (half square triangles)

Draw a diagonal line on the blue and pink 4" squares.

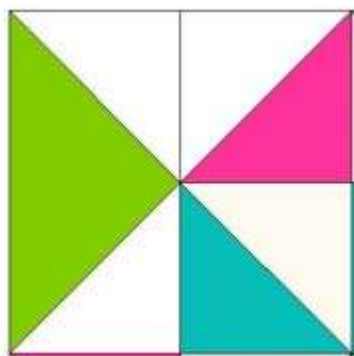
Lay a 4" white and a 4" pink square RST. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on either side of diagonal. Cut on drawn line. Open, press your two half square triangles with seams open and trim to $3\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat.

Repeat for the blue and white squares. Press seams open.

Following this image, sew the pink HST to the blue HST. Press. Repeat for other three.

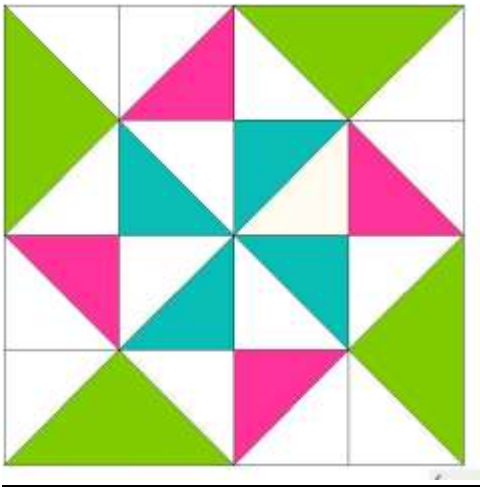


Sew the pink/blue unit to the green/white flying geese. Press. Repeat for other three.



Layout the 4 units and sew into rows. Then sew rows together.

TIP: pin at each seam so they match and ease the fabric in between the pins.
