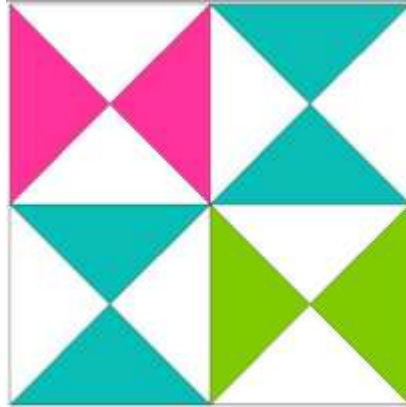


Cov-ercome

Block #3 – Any Day Can Be A Party!

Cutting

Blue fabric:

One 7 ¼" square

Green fabric:

One 7 ¼" square

White fabric:

Three 7 ¼" squares

Pink fabric:

One 7 ¼" square

Take a pink square and a white square and put right sides together. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the top one. Sew a scant ¼" on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line and press towards the pink.

Now lay the two new squares right sides together with the seam line on top of each other but the colours reversed, so the pink is laying on the white. Draw a new diagonal line going opposite way of the stitched line and sew a scant ¼" on both sides of drawn line. Cut apart and press. You now have two 6 ½" blocks. You will only use one.

Repeat with the green and white squares, again you will only use one.

Repeat with the blue and white squares and you will use both.

Lay out according to diagram and sew the top two units together and then the bottom two. Press and join the two rows together.



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
